Pass the Lower Costs, More Transparency Act!

The **Alliance to Fight for Health Care** supports site-neutral payment policies, which can be implemented in a way that protects rural patients from the <u>harmful effects of hospital consolidation</u>, <u>without disrupting the ability of rural hospitals to provide critical care</u>.

We support policies included in the House-passed Lower, Costs More Transparency Act (HR 5378) that aim to eliminate payment discrepancies based on the site-of-care for certain drug administration services. We urge the Senate to quickly take up these site-neutral payment reform proposals, which have broad stakeholder support representing physicians, employers, patient advocacy groups and more, including the Alliance to Fight for Health Care, American Benefits Council, Families USA, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) American Academy of Family Physicians, American College of Physicians, Community Oncology Alliance, US Oncology Network, National Restaurant Association, and more.
